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Scoring

Your final score for each test is **the number of the most difficult row where you got two or more correct** (which is half or more correct).

The most difficult line is **row 6** (it's the smallest).

Look at your results in row 6 first, then make your way up the chart.

EXAMPLE 1

6

Two or more correct?

You had two correct answers in row 6, so **your score is 6**.

EXAMPLE 2

5

Two or more correct?

You only had one correct answer in row 6, but you had three correct answers in row 5, so **your score is 5**.
